We have distributed over 100,000 R.O.C.K. wristbands to help increase public awareness for children with cancer. Cancer can make children feel different from other children, and that may be one of the disease's worst side effects of all. That's what makes R.O.C.K. Camp so special.

Established in 1976, R.O.C.K. Camp is the first camp for children with cancer in the United States. R.O.C.K. Camp is one of three American Cancer Society R.O.C.K. Programs in Florida. The other programs are Families R.O.C.K. Weekend and R.O.C.K. College Scholarships.

The American Cancer Society's R.O.C.K. Camp in partnership with Camp Boggy Creek serves children and teenagers ages 7-16 who are referred by pediatric oncology centers and private practices, currently being treated for cancer or who have not been off treatment for more than three years.
